Coinciding TLID's 3rd Anniversary, this Corporate Social Responsibility program with theme “Grow Mangrove, Grow Life” aims to strengthen the bond between the employees working together to conserve Indonesia’s rich natural environment and biodiversity and to realize a sustainable community for the future.

TLID employees and their family of 71 persons participated in this annual program. The program started with an educational briefing about mangrove ecosystem.

Entering muddy water and planting mangrove together bonded all participants and left them with an interesting experience. TLID and the employees hoped to continue their contribution to the Indonesian community and nature in and outside of Jakarta.

Mangrove ecosystems have a central role in transferring organic matter and energy from the land to marine ecosystems, stabilize coastlines, and have high biodiversity, such as birds, fish, and other sea lives. Mangroves are also extremely important to human communities by serving as natural dam to protect the coastal from erosion and siltation
